Dual Enrollment

What does it mean?

Courses that help students **fulfill high school graduation requirements** and **simultaneously make progress toward a college degree** or workforce credential.

In some cases, Early College students earn enough college credits to graduate from high school with an associate degree.

Dual Enrollment

Why should I do it?

- ✓ **Cost Savings** - Students can earn college credits at little or no cost.
- ✓ **College Readiness** - Early exposure to college-level coursework helps students develop the academic skills necessary for future success.
- ✓ **Increased Access** - Early College programs provide underrepresented or first-generation students with greater access to higher education opportunities
- ✓ **Boosted Confidence and Motivation** - Succeeding in college courses builds students' confidence in their abilities and motivates them to pursue further education and career goals.

Dual Enrollment Pathways



Exposure to Career-Related Courses

Students can explore various fields, such as healthcare, engineering, business, or technology, which helps them determine their interests and aptitudes early.

Career Navigation

Middle and High School Coordinator will help students to align their high school courses with long-term career goals, fostering a smoother transition into college or technical programs.

Access to Industry-Specific Certifications

Some dual enrollment courses offer certifications enabling students to qualify for entry-level jobs right after high school.

Atlantic Cape Degree or Transfer

Atlantic Cape offers **47 Associate Degree Programs** that prepare students to transition to the workforce or to further education.

Save Time and Money

Faster completion of college programs allows students to enter the workforce sooner, helping them pursue careers early with less student debt.



Dual Enrollment

How do I sign up?

Dual credit courses are **taught by EHTHS teachers** at the high school.

Tuition is only \$66.00 per credit with no additional costs for fees—a 60% discount on county resident tuition per credit at Atlantic Cape!

Egg Harbor Township High School currently offers 18 approved dual credit courses with Atlantic Cape.


What Can I Do With My College Credit?

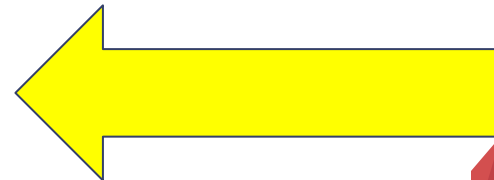

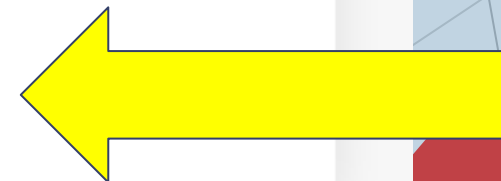
